

# California Hands & Voices Family Camp

***What to Bring – Label everything with your family name – Check the weather to be prepared!***

- Pillows, Blankets & Flat Sheets. *Most beds are twin size*, limited full size bunks depending on room.
- Study shoes ie. Tennis Shoes - Boots
- Toiletries, Towels, Shower Shoes
- Flashlight and Batteries
- Layered Clothing, Rain Jacket, All-Weather Clothes as weather conditions are unpredictable.
- Small day pack for each child - labeled with your name. (water bottle, light jacket, hat, chapstick etc.
- Hat, Sunscreen, Bug Repellent
- Water Bottles for each family member, Refillable Coffee Cups and Snacks
- Camera, charger/batteries
- Cochlear Implant Charger, Extra Hearing Aid Batteries, etc. (if applicable)
- Swim Suit (there is a *possibility* the pool will be warm enough to swim in during Family Time)
- Special instructions will be emailed related to the theme of camp.

Tips & Important Information to ensure we have a fun and safe experience at camp (From Whispering Wings)

- Coffee and tea in the Welcome Center and Coffee Corner 6:30am to 5:30pm; please help yourself!
- Quiet time at camp is from 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Stay hydrated with our convenient water-filling stations! Camp is 45000 above sea level.
- Please, no food or drinks in the Game Room, and adult supervision is required.
- Turning off lights, ac, or heater when you leave your room
- Pets are not allowed at camp (with the exception of service dogs).
- Alcohol is not permitted on camp property.
- The speed limit in camp is 10 m.p.h.
- Due to the threat of fire danger, smoking is not permitted in any buildings or in the forest.
- Please avoid parking in front of meeting halls
- When walking around camp, always walk in groups of 3 or more before sunup and after sundown for safety and for possible wildlife at camp. In the event that you spot a bobcat or mountain lion, DON'T RUN. Make eye contact with the animal, make yourself look really big, and make lots of noise.
- If there is an emergency onsite, you will continuously hear the meadow bell ring. That is your cue to gather in Founders Hall and await further instructions from our staff.
